What They Learn

Girls learn and practice the pro-social skills needed for success in middle school. Skills are taught directly practiced through role play, games, cooperative and competitive activities.

Social Bridges middle school curriculum focuses on the following core skills: self-esteem, growth-mindset, making and keeping friends, stress management, flexibility, communication skills, self-advocacy, social filter and social prediction.

Parents receive weekly written communication on their daughter's individual social goals and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing and coaching skills at home.
