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What They Learn

Drama is a research-based modality for learning and practicing social skills. Through improv activities, theater games, and scene work, group members learn the following core skills: turn-taking, expressing feelings with face, voice, and body, being flexible, and accepting feedback. This group is open to middle and high school students.
