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## What They Learn

Fifth and sixth graders learn and practice the pro-social skills needed to be successful. Skills are taught directly and practiced through role play, games, and cooperative and competitive activities.

Social Bridges 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum focuses on the following core skills: following social rules, emotional regulation, flexibility, communication skills, social filter, and social prediction.

The group will meet monthly in a community setting to help generalize skills.

Parents receive weekly written communication on their child's individual social goals and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing, and coaching skills at home.

## Tuition Rates & Financial Information

\$240.00 non-refundable deposit to ensure placement in the group is due two weeks prior to start of group sessions. This deposit will be credited towards the overall tuition.
