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What They Learn

In Friendship Group, children learn and practice the pro-social skills needed to be a helpful classmate, friend, and family and community member. Skills are taught directly and practiced through stories, games, and cooperative and competitive activities.

Social Bridges curriculum focuses on the following core skills: learning and following social rules, emotional regulation, turn-taking, joining in play and conversation skills. Social coaching is provided by facilitators to help the children use their social skills in the moment.

We hope to plan an outing with group members to practice and generalize skills in natural settings. More details to come!

Parents receive weekly written communication on their child's individual social goals and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing and coaching skills at home.
