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What They Learn

Participants in this group will focus on the transition/life skills/social emotional learning that are necessary for independent living. Suggested topics include:

- Budgeting and shopping
- Financial literacy /bill paying
- Options for independent transportation and ability to access
- Consumer awareness
- Household care
- Emergency situational problem solving
- Self- advocacy and assertive communication
- Accountability and responsibility for personal care/health care needs,
- Negotiating and compromising within the community (i.e. interacting with a roommate)

The format of the group will meet weekly; alternating between virtual and in person sessions:

- Direct teaching via Zoom - twice per month
- Transition/life skill practice & socialization in community settings twice per month

Parents receive weekly written communication on the group goals and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing and coaching skills at home.

Tuition Rates & Financial Information

New Families – \$1,380
Continuing Families- \$1,280

\$240.00 non-refundable deposit to ensure placement in the group is due at registration. This deposit will be credited towards the overall tuition.

Monthly payments are based on sessions held each month. Payment needs to be paid either in full at the beginning of the semester or paid monthly.

Insurance receipts will be provided monthly to those with current accounts through Simple Practice. Superbills are automatically generated the first week of each month and show all required information for reimbursements
