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What They Learn

Participants learn and practice the pro-social skills needed for success in middle school and high school. Skills are taught directly practiced through role play, games, cooperative and competitive activities.

Social Bridges middle school and high school curriculum focuses on the following core skills: self-esteem, growth-mindset, making and keeping friends, stress management, flexibility, communication skills, self-advocacy, social filter and social prediction.

The group will meet monthly in a community setting to help generalize skills.

Parents receive weekly written communication on their teen's individual social goals and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing and coaching skills at home.

Tuition Rates & Financial Information
