### **What They Learn**

Fourth and fifth graders learn and practice the pro-social skills needed to be a helpful classmate, friend, and family and community member. Skills are taught directly and practiced through stories, games, and cooperative and competitive activities.

Social Bridges 4-5 curriculum focuses on the following core skills: Following social rules, emotional regulation, flexibility, communication skills, social filter, and social prediction.

Parents receive weekly written Communication regarding the social tools their child is learning and suggestions for practicing, reinforcing, and coaching skills at home.

### **Tuition Rates & Financial Information**

**Tuition – \$ 1105**

**Tuition + New Family Fee – \$ 1205**

**\$130 non-refundable deposit** to ensure placement in the group is due at registration. This deposit will be credited towards the overall tuition.

Monthly payments are based on sessions held each month. Payment needs to be paid either in full at the beginning of the semester or paid monthly.
